	<i>Anigozanthos</i>	<i>flavidus</i> 'Landscape Violet'	Kangaroo Paw	Tall, hardy kangaroo Paw. H1- 2m x W0 .5 -1m. Flowers in Spring - Summer. Colour violet/mauve. Sun - Pt-sh. Attracts birds, suits pots. Protect from snails when young.
	<i>Anigozanthos</i>	'Orange Cross'	Kangaroo Paw	Tall clumping perennial. H1-1.2m with vivid orange flowers. Well drained sandy soil. Sunny open position. Protect from snails.
	<i>Anigozanthos</i>	'Yellow Gem'	Kangaroo Paw	Tall tough plant with great garden performance. Vibrant bicolour yellow flowers with red stems in late Sp - S. H1m xW1m. Protect from snails.
	<i>Balaskion</i>	<i>tetraphyllum</i>	Swamp Foxtails	Soft, foxtail clump forming rush. H 0.7 - 1m x W 0.4 - 0.7m. Flower spikes turn brown in spring and summer.Free draining soils and water courses.Suitable for ponds /containers and for flower arrangements.
2	<i>Blandfordia</i>	<i>grandiflora</i>	Christmas Bells	Grass like plant from Qld and NSW with large red & yellow bell shaped flowers on stems to 80cm. Moist but well drained soil. Sun to Pt Shade.

5	<i>Calostemma</i>	<i>purpureum</i>	Garland Lily	Bulbous plant with succulent strap like leaves. H35cm when flowering. Red trumpet like flowers in S. Full sun. Grows in most soils.
	<i>Carex</i>	<i>appressa</i>	Tall Sedge	Tussock forming. Spreads slowly. Moisture loving. H40-60cm x W40-60cm. Dull yellow to brownish spikelets in Sp-S.
	<i>Ficinia</i>	<i>nodosa</i>	Knobby Club Rush	Tight ball like brown flower head. H0.5-1m x W1+m. Likes winter moisture and/or swampy areas.
	<i>Gahnia</i>	<i>sieberiana</i>	Red Fruited Saw Sedge	Tussock forming plant to 2m H. Leaves have sharp serrations.Tall cream flower spikes can rise 1m above leaves. Food plant for Sword Grass Brown Butterfly.

	<i>Lepidosperma</i>	<i>concavum</i>	Sandhill Sword Sedge	Tufted perennial grass to 30cm. Spikes to 25 - 50cm in spring / summer. Sun -part shade. Well drained soils preferred. Birds feed on seed & fallen seed heads.
	<i>Libertia</i>	<i>paniculata</i>	Branching Grass Flag	Grass like perennial with profuse sprays of white flowers Sep-Nov. Shade to Pt Shade. Good drainage. Excellent for pots. H0.3-1.3m x W0.3-1.3m.
	<i>Lomandra</i>	<i>confertifolia</i> 'Little Con'	Mat Rush	Tussock forming. Pale green leaves to 80cm. Small cream flowers on hidden flower spikes. Hardy. Sun or part shade. Most soil types.
	<i>Lomandra</i>	<i>confertifolia</i> 'Little Pal'	Mat Rush	Small, hardy grass-like tuft. H & W0.4-0.8m. Small cream flowers on hidden flower spikes in summer. Suitable as border plant, pot plant, coastal and poolside plant. Sun or light shade. Drought resistant. Healthy new growth appears after pruning.

	<i>Patersonia</i>	<i>occidentalis</i> (Purple flower)	Long Purple Flag	Tuft forming plant to 0.8m. Pale blue/mauve or purple flowers Sp-early S. Most soils. Mulch well. Sun or part shade. Likes moisture.
	<i>Poa</i>	<i>labillardierei</i>	Large Tussock Grass	Large dense tussocks. Green to purplish spikes in late Sp-S. H0.8-1m x W0.8-1.2m. Hardy. Most soils. Shear to above ground level late winter early spring.
	<i>Rytidosperma</i>	<i>geniculatum</i>	Kneed Wallaby Grass	Tufted perennial grass to 30cm. Flower stems to 25cm in spring / summer. Sun -part shade. Moist soils preferred. Birds feed on seed & fallen seed heads. Used as native lawn but needs to go to seed.
	<i>Stylidium</i>	<i>dilatatum</i>		Tufted foliage and pink flowers on spikes to 50cm. Likes moist but well drained soils in partial shade.
4	<i>Thelionema</i>	<i>caespitosum</i>	Tufted Lily	Perennial. H 0.5-1m x W 0.6-1.3m. Starry flowers to 2.5cm across, deep blue to white or pale yellow. Sept- Feb. Sunny to semi- shaded. Requires good drainage in sandy and sandy loam soils.

	<i>Carpobrotus</i>	<i>rossii</i> (Purple)	Native Pigface	Hardy, spreading ground cover for dry areas. Succulent leaves, purple flowers in Sp & S.
	<i>Carpobrotus</i>	<i>rossii</i> (White)	Native Pigface	Hardy, spreading ground cover for dry areas. Succulent leaves, white flowers in Sp & S.
	<i>Chorizema</i>	<i>diversifolium</i>	Climbing Flame Pea	Light climber. H 1.0-1.5 x W 1.0-1.5 m. Racemes of small orange, yellow and purplish-pink pea flowers in spring. Sun / part shade. Sandy/ loam well drained soils. Withstands hard pruning.
	<i>Chrysocephalum</i>	<i>apiculatum</i>	Yellow Buttons	Evergreen, spreading perennial. Golden/yellow button flowers. Prefers sunny, moist but well drained position. Trim after flowering. Spreading 1 - 1.5m.
	<i>Darwinia</i>	<i>citriodora</i> (Prostrate form)	Lemon Scented Darwinia	Spreading plant. H0.3m x W1.2-1.5m. Fragrant foliage. Flowers yellow/green and red. Sun /Part Shade. Most soils .Responds well to pruning.
	<i>Darwinia</i>	<i>taxifolia ssp. macrolaena</i>		Attractive spreading shrub to H 0.2-1.0m x W 1-2m. Sun or part shade. Pink to deep red flowers in Sp or early S. Prune lightly after flowering.
	<i>Goodenia</i>	<i>humilis</i>	Swamp Goodenia	Moisture loving ground cover. Yellow flowers Sept to March. Grows to dense mat 1-1.5m wide.

3	<i>Marianthus</i>	<i>erubescens</i>	Red Billiardiera	Light climber with showy, deep red tubular flowers, to about 2cm long, in Sp-S. Sum to Pt Shade. Moist but well drained sandy - loam soil. Attracts honeyeaters.

	<i>Ranunculus</i>	<i>amphitrichus</i>	Small River-Buttercup	Water-loving groundcover (H 0.3m x W 0.2-0.5m) with small, bright yellow flowers in spring. Needs shade. Moist soils all year round.
	<i>Scaevola</i>	<i>albida</i> (White)	Small Fruit Fan Flower	Clumping groundcover H20cm x W1m. Attractive white fan flowers in Sp-S. Semi hardy. Sun or part shade. Sandy loam.
	<i>Scaevola</i>	<i>albida</i> (Blue)	Small Fruit Fan Flower	Clumping groundcover H 0.2 x W 1m. Blue fan shaped flowers in Sp-S. Semi-hardy. Sun or Part shade. Sandy loam.

	<i>Viola</i>	<i>eminens</i>		Perennial groundcover. H 0.1-0.2m x W 0.5-1m. Violet and white flowers throughout Aug - Dec. Part shade. Moist soils. Suitable for containers, rockeries and underplanting
	<i>Viola</i>	<i>hederacea</i>	Native Violet	Moisture loving ground cover. Likes semi shade. Small mauve flowers most of year. Grows 15cm tall x 1-1.5m wide.
