Anigozanthos	'Orange Cross'	B	Kangaroo Paw	Plant with great garden performance. Orange flowers late Sp - S. H1-1.3m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most soils. Cut to ground level in Aut; feed in Aut & Sp. Protect from snails. Attracts birds.
Anigozanthos	'Yellow Gem'	B	Kangaroo Paw	Great garden performance. Yellow flowers with red stems late Sp - S. H1m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most soils. Cut to ground level in Aut; feed in Aut & Sp. Protect from snails. Attracts birds.
Conostylis	aculeata	B		Variable clumping plant with yellow clusters of flowers in Spring - Summer. H0.20-0.40m x W0.50 -0.80m. Sun / Pt shade. Sandy loam soils.
Crinum	pendunculatum	B	Swamp Lily	Large feature plant with upright leaves and white, pleasantly perfumed flowers Sp-Sum. H&W 2.0-3.0m. Sun/Pt-shade. Poorly drained soils. Excellent around water feature.
Libertia	paniculata	B	Branching Grass Flag	Attractive, tufting plant with sprays of scented, white flowers Sp. H30-60cm x W50-80cm. Pt/Full-shade. Well-drained light soils. Excellent for pots. Protect from slugs and snails.
Lomandra	'Lime Tuff'	B	Mat Bush	Evergreen perennial grass, with cream flowers in Spring. H&W 0.5-0.6m. Sun/light shade. All soils. Responds to hard cutback. Attracts bees, insects and lizards
Orthrosanthus	multiflorus	B	Morning Flag	Tufting, perennial plant with strap like leaves and pale mauve flowers on stems up to 1 tall in spring. H0.5-0.8m x W0.7-1m. Sun/Pt-sh. in moist, well drained sandy, loam soils.
Asplenium	australasicum	Fern	Birds Nest Fern	Large growing fern with leathery leaves. H1-2m x W4m. Pt-sun/shade position. Plant crown above soil line. Well drained soils. Keep moist in dry periods. Protect from frosts.
Doodia	aspera	Fern	Rasp Fern	Clump-forming fern. H&W0.4m. Performs best in a humus rich soil in dappled shade. Protect from afternoon sun. Can be grown in containers.
Acacia	implexa	G	Hickory Wattle	Upright to spreading tall shrub, pale yellow flowers in Sum. H8m x W7m. Full/Pt-sun or dappled shade. Well drained soils. Useful as a windbreak, shelter or shade.
Acacia	melanoxydon	G	Blackwood	Tree with cream to pale yellow gobular flowers in Sp. H8-12m x W6-8m. F-sun/Pt-shade. Moist well drained soils. Long lived. Frost tolerant. Leaves suitable as a dyeing material.

Allocasuarina	littoralis	G	Black She-oak	Hardy tree with slender foliage and deeply furrowed bark. Small male and female flowers on separate trees. H8-12m x W4-7m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most well drained soils. Excellent wind break.
Allocasuarina	paludosa	G	Scrub Sheoak	Bushy shrub with slender foliage. Small male (brownish) or female (reddish) flowers on separate plants in Au-W-Sp H1.5-2m x W1-1.3m. Sun/Pt-shade. All moist to wet soils.
Amperea	xiphoclada	G	Broom Spurge	Hardy, erect, dwarf shrub with flowers borne at the nodes in very small cream clusters in Sp-S. H0.5-1m x W0.5m. Most light soils. Suitable for rockeries.
Banksia	marginata	G	Silver Banksia	Hardy shrub with yellow, showy flower-spikes to 10cm long. H2.5-4m x W2-3m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soils. Benefits from a light pruning. Attracts birds.
Bulbine	semibarbata	G	Leek Lily	Perennial with yellow flowers on stems to 40cm tall in Sp-S. May die back to tuberous rootstock late summer. H20-40cm x W10-20cm. Full sun to Pt-shade. Most soils.
Dillwynia	glaberrima	G	Smooth Parrot-pea	Shrub with erect branches and yellow with red pea-flowers in Sp. H1-1.5m x W1.2m. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained soils. Frost tolerant.
Diplarrena	moroea	G	Butterfly Flag	Upright, clump forming plant with fragrant white flowers with violet centre in spring. H0.6m x W0.5-1m. Sun/Pt-shade. Suitable for bog gardens, rockeries, and pots.
Eucalyptus	viminalis	G	Manna Gum	Medium to very tall tree, white flowers in Jan to May. H10-50m x W8-15m. Suitable for wide range of well-drained soils and situations. Good for bees, koalas. Too big for home gardens.
Ficinia	nodosa	G	Knobby Club Rush	A sedge with tight ball-like, brown flower heads. H0.5-1m x W1m. Sun/Pt-shade. Likes winter moisture and/or sandy, swampy areas. Drought and frost tolerant.
Gahnia	sieberiana	G	Red-fruited Saw Sedge	Tussock plant with sharp, serrated leaves. H to 2m. Tall, black, feathery flower-spikes can rise 1m above leaves and make an excellent fresh/dried floral decoration. Sun/Pt-sh.
Goodenia	ovata	G	Hop Goodenia	Quick growing shrub with abundant, yellow flowers Sp-S. H&W 1-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soils. Prune when young. Good filler plant. Attracts insects.
Hakea	nodosa	G	Yellow Hakea	Large, hardy shrub with yellow flowers in late Aut-W. H2-3m x W2-3m. Most well drained soils in a sunny or part shady position. Withstands dry periods. Attracts birds.
Indigofera	australis	G	Austral Indigo	Hardy, variable shrub with open foliage and racemes of white or pink to purple pea-flowers in late W-Sp. H1-2m x W1.5-2.5m. Sun/Pt-shade in most soils. Benefits from pruning.
Leptospermum	continentale	G	Prickly Tea-tree	Hardy, erect shrub with profuse, white flrs. late Sp-S. H&W3-4.5m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most soils. Will grow in wet conditions. Withstands dry periods. Bird habitat plant. Prune when young.
Lomandra	longifolia	G	Spiny-headed Mat Rush	Hardy lomandra with light-scented cream flowers in spikes to 1m in Sp-early S. H0.5-1m X W0.8-1.2m. Sun/Pt/F-sh. All soils. Prune to ground level for new growth. Wild-life habitat.
Mentha	australis	G	River Mint	Suckering, strongly aromatic, edible herb with white to purplish flowers in Sp-S-Aut. H30-60cm x W30-100cm. Can be invasive best grown in pots.
Microleana	stipoides	G	Weeping Grass	Tufted perennial grass. H20cm with 40cm spikelets Sp to Aut. Green all year F-sun/semi-sh. Tolerates acid soils, drought and frost. Prune in W for new growth. Attract seed-eating birds, caterpillars.
Microseris	scapigera	G	Yam daisy	Perennial herb with bright yellow, daisy-like flowers W-Sp and fleshy edible tubers when mature. Sun/Pt-sh. Well drained soil. Frost hardy. Does well in rockeries and containers.
Olearia	lirata	G	Snowy Daisy-bush	Hardy, open shrub with large white daisy flowers in loose clusters in Sp. H1.5-2m x W1.2-1.8m. Shady position in most, moist, well drained soils. Benefits from pruning.
Pimelea	humilis	G	Common Rice-flower	Low, clumping, suckering plant with white flowerheads Sp-S. H30cm x W40-80cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist but well drained soils. Withstands dry periods. Light trim beneficial.

Platylobium	obtusangulum	G	Angled Flat-pea	Hardy, clump forming plant with arrowhead-shaped leaves and yellow with red pea-flowers in Sp. H0.5-0.8m x W0.8-1.2m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most well drained soils. Withstands dry periods.
Poa	labillardieri	G	Large Tussock-grass	Bluish-green tussock with soft green to purplish feathery spikelets in late Sp-S. H0.8-1m x W0.8-1.2m. F-sun/Pt-sh. Most well drained soils. Cut back in W. Withstands dry periods.
Senecio	pinnatifolius var lanceolat	G	Variable groundsel	Herb, bright yellow flowers in Spr - Sum. H0.5-1.0m x W0.3-0.7m. Dappled / semi shade. Food for caterpillars and bees. Keep pruned. Indig to RBG Cranbourne. Study being done on this species.
Spyridium	parvifolium	G	Dusty Miller	Shrub with clusters of small, whitish flowers W-Sp. H1.5-2.5 x W1.2-1.8m. Full-sh/Pt-shade. Most, moist, well drained soils. Withstands dry periods. Benefits from pruning.
Styloidium	graminifolium	G	Grass Trigger Plant	Tufted plant with numerous pale to dark pink flowers on stems 50cm in length late Sp/S. F-sun/Pt-shade. H&W 30cm. Moist, well drained sandy/loam soils. Attracts insects.
Tetragonia	tetragonioides	G	Warrigal Spinach	Succulent, edible, trailing plant with tiny yellow flowers Sp-S-Aut. H20cm x W2m. Sun/pt-shade. Well drained sandy/loam soils. Gap filler. Treat as an annual. Attracts lizards.
Trachymene	composita	G	Parsnip Lace-flower	Tap rooted annual or perennial herb with beautiful large lace-like umbels in spring. Flowers on 2.5 m. long stems. Foliage 0.5m. Sandy soils. Edible root. Lovely cut flower.
Viminaria	juncea	G	Golden Spray	Slender, erect, fast-growing shrub with pendent sprays of yellow pea-flowers in Sp-S. H3-4m x W2-3m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most soils. Withstands dry/wet periods. Trim to promote bushiness.
Billardiera	cymosa	O	Sweet Apple Berry	Hardy, shrubby, slender climber with bluish, greenish or cream flowers followed by reddish berries in Sp. H1.0 - 2.0m. Sun. Drained light to heavy soils. Protect from snails.
Carpobrotus	rossii (pink/purple flower)	O	Native Pigface	Hardy, spreading ground cover with succulent leaves and purple flowers in Sp & S. Spreads to 2m. Sunny position in well-drained soils. Suitable for dry areas.
Clematis	aristata	O	Old Man's Beard	Medium climber with showy, white flowers varying in size and feathery seedheads W-Sum. H 6m x W2m. F-sun/Pt-sh. All well drained soils. Likes cool root area.
Correa	reflexa (prostrate, red/gre	O	Common Correa	Densely foliated ground cover with red/green bells winter and spring. H0.4m. Sun/Semi-shade. Most soils. Prune to create bushiness. Attracts Birds.
Hardenbergia	comptoniana	O	Native Wisteria	Medium climber with sprays of purple pea-flowers in Spr. H0.3m x W3m. Will tolerate full sun but does better in light shade. Most well-drained soil types. Attracts butterflies.
Hardenbergia	violacea (pink flower)	O	False Sarsaparilla	Medium vigorous climber with sprays of pink pea-flowers in W-Sp. Will tolerate full sun but does better in light shade. Most well drained soils. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Hibbertia	grossulariifolia	O	Gooseberry Leaved Guinea	Spreading, layering groundcover with bright yellow flowers in Sp. H30-50cm x W1-2.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soil types.
Hibbertia	scandens	O	Climbing Guinea Flower	Layering climber/groundcover with large, open-petalled, scented, yellow flowers mainly in spring and sporadically throughout the year. Sun/Part-shade. Most well drained soils.
Jasminium	suavissimum	O	Sweet Jasmine	Climbing/scrambling plant which may self-layer on the ground. White flowers with delightful fragrance in Sp-S. Sun/Pt-sh. in most soils. Withstands dry periods. Prune if desired.
Kennedia	beckxiana	O	Cape Arid Climber	Medium, vigorous climber or prostrate groundcover with pea-shaped scarlet and green flowers late Sp-S. Most free-draining soils. Prune to encourage dense foliage. Attracts birds.
Kennedia	coccinea	O	Coral Vine	Quick-growing climber with spectacular deep pink, orange and yellow flowers in Sp. Part-shade. Most soils. Short lived but well worth growing.
Kunzea	pomifera	O	Muntries	Hardy groundcover with white flowers in spring followed by edible, purplish, fleshy fruits. H10-30cm x W2m. Sun/Pt-shade in most well drained soils. Withstands dry periods.

Myoporum	parvifolium (broad leaf)	O	Creeping boobialla	Prostrate groundcover with small star-shaped white flowers in late Spring to early Autumn. H0.10m x W 2-3m. Full sun/part shade. Wide range of soils incl coast and clay. Tolerates heat and frost.
Myoporum	parvifolium (pink flower)	O	Creeping Boobialla	Creeping, self-layering groundcover with small, pink flowers late W-Sp. H10-30cm x W1.5-3m. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist but well drained soils. Withstands dry periods.
Pandorea	jasminoides	O	Bower of Beauty	Hardy, vigorous climber with a wide spread and large, pink trumpet flowers Sp-Aut. Sun/Pt-shade. Most well drained, moist soils. Withstands dry periods.
Persoonia	chamaepitys	O	Mountain Geebung	Dense groundcover with showy display of yellow flowers in Summer. H0.2-0.3m x W1.2-2m.Sun/Pt shade.Moist, sandy or loam soils. Withstands dry periods.Good for rockeries.
Pultenaea	pedunculata (orange flow)	O	Matt Bush-pea	Excellent groundcover with burnt orange pea-flowers in Sp. H0.1m x W1-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most, moist well drained soils. Pruning recommended. Suitable for hanging baskets.
Pultenaea	pedunculata 'Pyolong Gol	O	Matt Bush-pea	Excellent groundcover with golden-yellow pea-flowers in Sp. H0.1m x W1-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most, moist well drained soils. Pruning recommended. Suitable for hanging baskets.
Scaevola	albida 'Mauve Clusters'	O	Fan-flower	Excellent, dense, low groundcover with mauve fan-flowers in late Sp-S-Aut. H20cm x W1-2m. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist but well drained sandy/loam soils. Withstands dry periods.
Scleranthus	biflorus	O	Knawel	Dense, light green, moss-like plant with small, insignificant flowers in Sum. Mounding mat 0.1m x W0.3-1m. Part or dappled shade. Suits rockeries, borders, gardens and containers.
Thomasia	pygmaea	O	Dwarf Paper-flower	Ornamental plant with profuse display of small, mauve-pink pendent flowers in Sp. H20-30cm x W50-80cm. S/Pt-sh. Drained, sandy/loam soils. Withstands dry periods. Trim beneficial.
Baeckea	virgata (dwarf form)	O/Y	Twiggy Heath Myrtle Dwarf	Small rounded shrub with masses of white flowers in Summer. H0.3m-W0.5m.Half sun/half shade. Well drained soils. Responds to pruning.
Brachyscome	multifida (mauve flower)	O/Y	Cut-Leaf Daisy	Attractive, long flowering, small plant with mauve flowers late W-Aut. H20cm x W50cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soils. A light prune and feed promotes flowering.
Brachyscome	multifida (white flower)	O/Y	Cut-Leaf Daisy	Attractive, long flowering small plant with white flowers Aug - May. 20cm x 50cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soils. Prune to promote flowering.
Chrysocephalum	apiculatum	O/Y	Yellow Buttons	Evergreen, spreading groundcover with golden-yellow, button flowers Sp-S-Aut. H0.2m x W1-1.5m. Prefers sunny, moist but well drained position. Trim to promote more flowers.
Chrysocephalum	apiculatum Grey form	O/Y	Yellow buttons	Evergreen, spreading perennial. Golden/yellow button flowers. Prefers sunny, moist but well drained position. Trim after flowering.
Dampiera	diversifolia	O/Y	Kangaroo Lobelia	Suckering, trailing plant with many deep blue flowers in Sp-S. H20-30cm x W0.8-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist well drained position.
Halgania	cyanea	O/Y	Rough Halgania	Hardy plant in most situations - may sucker lightly. Deep blue flowers in Sp-S. H20-30cm x W30-60cm. Sun/Pt-Shade. Most soils. Attracts bees.
Hibbertia	pedunculata	O/Y	Stalked Guinea Flower	Small shrub with yellow flowers from Sp-S. H0.2 x W0.5-1m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most well drained soils. Prune lightly. Suitable for containers and borders. Attracts butterflies.
Hibbertia	'Sun Drops'	O/Y	Guinea Flower	Groundcover with a profusion of bright golden flowers late W to S. H30cm x W50cm. Full-sun/Pt-shade. Most soils. Suitable for containers and hanging baskets. Attracts insects.
Homoranthus	darwinoides	O/Y	Fairy Bells	<i>Homoranthus darwinoides</i> is a small, spreading shrub H1-1.5 m xW 60 cm wide. The pendulous, conspicuous yellow and pink flowers in Sp to S.
Lechenaultia	biloba (pale blue flower)	O/Y	Blue Lechenaultia	Small shrub with pale blue flowers in Sp. H0.3m x W0.3m. Full sun. Treat as annual but may survive a few years. Drained soils. Best in pots. Prune to promote growth and flowers.

Plectranthus	parviflorus 'Blue Spires'	O/Y	Spur flower	Fast growing, Clumping plant with blue flower spikes from Sp to Aut. H0.4-0.5m x W0.3x0.4m. Sun-Pt-shade in good drainage. Prune periodically. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Pultenaea	pedunculata (pink flowers)	O/Y	Matted pea bush	Excellent groundcover with pink pea-flowers in Sp. H0.1m x W1-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most, moist well drained soils. Pruning recommended. Suitable for hanging baskets.
Pycnosorus	chrysanthes	O/Y	Golden Billy Buttons	Tufting plant with upright, bright yellow, globular flower heads in Sp-S, H&W 30cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Most, moist but well drained soils. Withstands dry periods.
Pycnosorus	globosus	O/Y	Drumsticks	Tufted plant with globular, bright yellow flowerheads in Sp-S. H40-50cm x W50cm. Sunny position in moist but well drained soils. Suitable for indoors either fresh or dried.
Rhodanthe	anthemoides 'Paper Baby'	O/Y	Chamomile Sunray	Semi-hardy groundcover with burgundy buds turning to white paper daisy flowers. H20-30cm x W60cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained sandy or loam soils. Light prune after flowering.
Scaevola	aemula (blue flower)	O/Y	Fairy Fan-flower	Dense, showy groundcover with blue fan-flowers from late Sp-Aut. H30cm x W0.5-1m. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist, well drained sandy or loam soils. A light prune encourages more flowers.
Scaevola	aemula (pink flower)	O/Y	Fairy Fan-flower	Dense, showy groundcover with pink fan-flowers from late Sp-Aut. H30cm x W0.5-1m. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist, well drained sandy or loam soils. A light prune encourages more flowers.

Scaevola	albida 'Mauve Dome'	O/Y	Fan-flower	Spreading, mound-forming groundcover with a profusion of mauve fan-flowers in Sp-S-Aut. H30cm x W50cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist but well drained sandy/loam soil. Withstands dry periods.
Scaevola	calendulacea	O/Y	Dune Fan-flower	Dwarf, spreading shrub with bright blue flowers 3cm across for most of the year. H0.5m x W0.8-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Suitable for coastal position. Cut-flower.
Tetradlea	ciliata (pink flower)	O/Y	Pink Bells	Clump forming plant with a showy display of pink flowers in spring. H20-50cm x W30-60cm. Filtered sun/Pt-shade. Well drained sandy/loam soils. Withstands dry periods. Tip prune.
Tetradlea	thymifolia	O/Y	Black-eyed Susan	Plant with a showy display of purplish-pink flowers W-Sp-S. H0.4-1m x W0.6-1m. Filtered sun. Moist, well-drained sandy/loam soils. Withstands dry periods. Suckers slightly.
Tetradlea	thymifolia (white flower)	O/Y	Black-eyed Susan	Plant with a showy display of white flowers W-Sp-S. H0.4-1m x W0.6-1m. Filtered sun. Moist, well drained sandy/loam soils. Withstands dry periods. Suckers slightly.
Veronica	nivea	O/Y	Snow Speedwell	Dwarf shrub with pale lilac or whitish-blue flowers in Sp-S. H0.2-0.4m x W0.3-0.6m. Sun/Dappled shade. Well drained soils. Tip prune regularly. Tolerates frost/snowfalls.
Adenanthos	detmoldii	P	Yellow Jugflower	Attractive, grey foliated plant with narrow, yellow to orange tubular flowers in late W-Sp. H1.2-1.8m x W1-1.3m. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained soil. Prune to shape. Attracts birds
Adenanthos	sericeus	P	Woolly Bush	Attractive bush with soft, grey-green foliage and small red flowers Sp-Sum. H2-3m x W1.5-3m. Well drained sandy/loam soil. Suits coastal garden. Prune to shape. Attracts birds.
Alyogyne	huegelii 'West Coast Gem'	P	Purple Hibiscus	Hardy, bushy shrub with blue flowers Sp-Aut. H2.5mx W2.5m. Full sun/Pt-shade. Well drained sandy loam soils. Prune after flowering to maintain shape. Attracts insects.
Atriplex	nummularia	P	Old Man Saltbush	Hardy, silvery-grey shrub with very small flowers. H1-2m x W2-3m. Well drained sunny position. Prune to shape and desired height. Edible leaves. Tolerates dry conditions. .
Atriplex	rhagodioides	P	Silver Saltbush	Hardy, dense, spreading shrub with silvery-grey foliage and insignificant flowers. H1-2m xW2m. All soils in sunny position. Very low water requirement. Drought and salt tolerant.

Araucaria	bidwillii	P	Bunya Pine	Fast-growing, large, feature tree 30-50m tall at full height with a straight dark-brown furrowed trunk. Trees begin the bear large cones at about 14 years of age. The cones contain large edible nut when roasted.
Bauera	sessiliflora	P	Grampians Bauera	Semi-hardy, spreading plant with showy magenta flowers in spring . H1.8m x W2m. Prefers part-shade in well drained soil. Prune after flowering. Tolerates dry periods.
Beaufortia	sparsa (orange flower)	P	Gravel Bottlebrush	Bush with orange bottle brush flowers Dec-April. H1.3-2m x W0.8-1.5m. Well drained soil in sunny position. Prune behind flower heads to promote growth. Attracts birds
Boronia	clavata	P	Bremer Boronia	Much branched shrub with bell-like pale yellow/green flowers with delicate perfume Aug-Jan. H1.5-2.5m x W1.5-3m. Pt-shade. Wide range of soils. Responds to light pruning.
Boronia	'Telopea Valley Star'	P		Vigorous medium shrub H1.4-2m x W1-2m. Showy display of deep pink, starry flowers in Sp. Sun to part shade.Prefers loam and sand. Keep moist and prune after flowering.
Bossiaea	dentata	P		Small to medium erect shrub with orange-red or yellow pea-shaped flowers April -Dec. H 2.0m x W 2.0m.Dappled shade or part sun.Well drained soils.Prune after flowering.Good in coastal, windy.
