<i>Acacia</i>	<i>binervia</i>	Coast Myall Wattle	R	Adaptable, small tree with rod-like yellow flowers in spring. H&W 5-8m. Sunny position in well drained soils. Drought and frost tolerant. Attracts wildlife. Good for erosion control.
<i>Acacia</i>	<i>boormanii</i>	Snowy River Wattle	R	Small tree with bright yellow flowers in late W-Sp. H to 4m. Tolerates most well-drained soils. Prune for bushiness. Spectacular when in flower. Tends to sucker.
<i>Acacia</i>	<i>brownii</i>	Heath Wattle	G	Open-branched shrub with prickly foliage and bright, golden yellow flowerheads in W/Sp. H&W1m. Dappled shade/Pt-sun. Moist, well drained soil. Provides protection for small birds.
<i>Acacia</i>	<i>calamifolia</i>	Wallowa	R	Semi-weeping shrub with golden flower-balls W-Sp. H2-3m x W2-4m. Full or part sun. Dry, wet, or well drained soils.
<i>Acacia</i>	<i>cardiophylla</i>	Wyalong Wattle	R	Attractive, spreading wattle with bright yellow, sweetly scented flowers in Spring. H1-2.0m x W2-3m. Sunny position. Prune regularly. Well drained soil. Frost and drought tolerant.
<i>Acacia</i>	<i>cyclops</i>	Round-seeded Acacia	R	Ornamental medium shrub with dense foliage and globular yellow flowers Sept - Oct. H & W 2.0 - 4.0m. Partial or full sun. Most soils. Good for windbreaks, coastal planting, soil erosion.
<i>Acacia</i>	<i>gladiiformis</i>	Sword wattle	R	Ornamental small to tall shrub with dense globular bright yellow flowers in Nov - Feb. H1.0-4.0m x W0.5-1.5m. Sun to semi-shade. Well-drained soils. Prune regularly.

<i>Acacia</i>	<i>oxycedrus</i>	Spike Wattle	G	Hardy, prickly, dense shrub with rod-shaped, lemon yellow flower-spikes in W-Sp. H2-3m x W2m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most well-drained soils. Suitable as hedge and screen plant.
