Acacia	acinacea 'Ruby Tips'	R	Gold Dust Wattle	Spreading shrub with deep golden yellow flowers and reddish new growth, July- Sept. H to 1.2m x W 1.0-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. All well drained soils. Prune to promote dense bush.
Acacia	aphylla	R	Leafless Rock Wattle	Unusual, leafless wattle with pale yellow flower-balls in spring. H3m x W2m. Well drained soil. Full sun. Prune to promote bushiness. Makes an unusual container plant.
Acacia	binervia	R	Coast Myall Wattle	Adaptable, small tree with rod-like yellow flowers in spring. H&W 5-8m. Sunny position in well drained soils. Drought and frost tolerant. Attracts wildlife. Good for erosion control.
Acacia	cognata	R	Bower or River Wattle	Graceful, light-foliaged, tall shrub/small tree with a pendulous habit and pale-yellow globular flowers in Sp. H4-8m x W4-6m. Full sun/Pt-sh. Well drained soil. Attracts birds.
Acacia	fimbriata	R		Dense, medium shrub with bright, globular flowers in W-Sp. H2-3m x W2-6m. Sun to Pt-shade. Light to heavy well drained soils. An adaptable species.
Acacia	gladiiformis	R	Sword wattle	Ornamental small to tall shrub with dense globular bright yellow flowers in Nov - Feb. H1.0-4.0m x W0.5-1.5m. Sun to semi-shade. Well-drained soils. Prune regularly.
Acacia	montana	R	Mallee Wattle	Medium-large, fast-growing shrub with bright yellow flowers in Spring. H& W 2-3.5m. Full/part sun. All soils with good drainage. Prune as flowers fade. Frost tolerant.
Acacia	oxycedrus	R	Spike Wattle	Hardy, prickly, dense shrub with rod-shaped, lemon yellow flower-spikes in W-Sp. H2-3m x W2m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most well-drained soils. Suitable as hedge and screen plant.
Acacia	spectabilis	R	Mudgee Wattle	A showy wattle with golden-yellow flower heads W-Sp. H3-5m x W2-3m. Prefers sunny position and most, well-drained soils. Drought resistant and frost tolerant.
Acacia	suaveolens	R	Sweet Wattle	Open-branched shrub with fragrant pale-yellow terminal flowers Aut-W-Sp. H1.5-2.5 x W1.5-3m. Sun/Pt-shade and well drained soil. Withstand dry period. Responds to pruning.

Ajuga	australis	O/Y	Austral Bugle	Spreading plant with erect purple/blue tubular flowers Sept-Feb. H0.1-0.6m x W0.1-0.5m. Dappled to full shade. All soils.
Allocasuarina	paludosa	P	Scrub Sheoak	Bushy shrub with slender foliage. Small male (brownish) or female (reddish) flowers on separate plants in Au-W-Sp H1.5-2m x W1-1.3m. Sun/Pt-shade. All moist to wet soils.
Alyogyne	huegelii (white flowers)	P	Native Hibiscus	Hardy shrub with white flowers Sp-Aut. H2.5mx W2.5m. Full sun/Pt-shade. Well drained sandy loam soils. Prune after flowering to maintain shape. Attracts insects.
Alyogyne	'Blue Heeler'	Y	Native Hibiscus	Small shrub with mauve to purple flowers Sp-Sum. H0.5-0.7m x W0.8-1.0m. Sun/light shade. All well drained soils. Attracts bees, butterflies and other insects.
Anigozanthos	flavidus (red flower)	B	Tall Kangaroo Paw	Plant with great garden performance. Reddish flowers late Sp - S. H to 2m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most soils. Cut to ground level in Aut; feed in Aut & Sp. Protect from snails. Attracts birds.
Anigozanthos	'Pink Beauty'	B	Kangaroo Paw	Small Kangaroo Paw with deep pink flowers in Sp-Sum. H0.50m x W0.30m.Sun/part shade,well-drained soils.Cut to gr level in Aut, feed in A & Sp. Protect from snails. Suits pots
Anigozanthos	'Yellow Gem'	B	Kangaroo Paw	Great garden performance. Yellow flowers with red stems late Sp - S. H1m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most soils. Cut to ground level in Aut; feed in Aut & Sp. Protect from snails. Attracts birds.
Aphanopetalum	resinosum	O	Gum Vine	Light to med climber with profuse small green/white flowers in Sp. Most soils. Sun to Pt Shade. Hardy in most situations. Also good as a ground Rambler.
Arthropodium	milleflorum	G	Pale Vanilla Lily	Grass-like plant with numerous small, vanilla-scented pale mauve flowers on branched stems to 80cm tall late Sp-S. H20-40cm x W30-50cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained position.
Arthropodium	strictum	G	Chocolate Lily	Grass-like plant with chocolate-scented bluish-mauve flowers on slender stems to 1m. tall late Sp-S. H20-40cm x W20-50cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained position.
Astartea	fascicularis	Y	False Baeckea	Hardy, variable shrub with white to pink flowers in Sp-S. H1-1.5m x W1-2m. Sun/Pt sh. Most soils. Prune to create bushiness. Excellent cut flower
Atriplex	nummularia	P	Old Man Saltbush	Hardy, silvery-grey shrub with very small flowers. H1-2m x W2-3m. Well drained sunny position. Prune to shape and desired height. Edible leaves. Tolerates dry conditions. .
Austromyrtus	dulcis	Y	Midgen Berry	Hardy, shrub with showy, pinkish-bronze new leaves; small white flowers in Sp-S. followed by edible berries. H0.5m x W1-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Tip-prune. Attracts birds and insects.
Austrostipa	stipoides	G	Coast Spear-Grass	Dense clumping tussock grass with silver-white spikes, Spr-Sum. H&W 0.8m. Full sun. Sandy/loam soils. Attracts seed-eating birds. Salt and wind tolerant. Tolerates dry periods
Backhousia	citriodora	P	Lemon-scented Myrtle	Tree with profuse cream flowers in Sp. H4-6m. Sun/Pt-shade; moist, well drained soils. Lemon scented leaves can be used as an infusion and for flavouring dishes. Tip prune.
Baeckea	virgata 'La Petite'	O/Y		Spreading shrub with dense, yellowish foliage and masses of small white flowers W-Sp. H0.5-1m x W0.5-1m. Full sun/Pt-shade. Well drained, moist soil. Makes lovely low hedge.
Baloskion	tetraphyllum	B	Swamp Foxtails	Soft, grass-like clump-forming rush. H1-1.5m x W0.4-1m. Flower turns brown in Sp-Sum. Most soils. Suitable for watercourses, ponds, bog gardens, containers and flower arrangements.

Banksia	blechnifolia	R	Fern-leaf Banksia	Dramatic ground cover with dusky-red flower-spikes at ground level on long, lateral branches in Sp-S. Deep lobed leaves to 50cm. Sunny position in a sandy loam. Attracts birds.
Banksia	ericifolia	R	Heath Banksia	Small to large compact shrub with prickly foliage and orange - red flowers April to Sept. H2-5m x W1-2.5m. Warm position. Well-drained soils. Prune for bushiness. Attracts honeyeaters
Banksia	ericifolia 'Harlequin'	R	Heath Banksia cultivar	Large shrub H4m W4m. Red-white flower spikes W-Sp. Sun/Pt-shade. Frost hardy. Thick needle-like foliage. E coast native tolerates most soil types. Attracts birds. Can be pruned.
Banksia	fraseri	R		Semi prostrate or erect shrub with bright yellow flowerheads Aut - W. H0.2 -1m x W1m. Full sun/light shade. Well drained loam soils. Prune to maintain bushiness. Attracts birds.
Banksia	'Giant Candles'	R		Shrub with honey coloured flower-spikes 30-40cm long in W-Sp. H3-4m x W2-3m. Full-filtered sun. Moist but well-drained soils. Withstands dry periods. Attracts birds.

Banksia	lemanniana	R	Yellow Lantern Banksia	Dense shrub with yellow-green flowers July - Dec. H&W2.0-4.0m. Well drained soils. F-sun/Pt-shade. Withstands frost, drought, some coast exposure. Good windbreak. Attracts birds.
Banksia	oreophila	R	Western Mountain Banksia	Hardy shrub with pale mauve to pink flowers with cream pistils, W-Sp. H 3m. Full sun/ light shade. Well drained soils. Tidy prune only. Cold tolerant, not for humid or arid conditions.
Banksia	paludosa	R	Marsh Banksia	Hardy, low spreading shrub with greenish-yellow flower spikes in most of the year. H0.5-0.8m x W0.8 -1.5m Sun/Pt-shade. All moist, well drained soils. Attracts birds. Slow growing.
Banksia	plagiocarpa	R	Hinchinbrook Blue Banksia	A rare shrub to 5m, can be pruned. Flowers unusual blue-grey up to 14cm. Grows in well drained sandy loam-gravel on a slope in cooler areas. Attractive red velvety new foliage.
Banksia	praemorsa (Red fl) - Low shrub form	R		Cut leaf banksia. New growth soft rusty brown. Large red flower spikes. H2.0m x W 3.0m. Well drained soil. Hardy. Full sun.

Banksia	speciosa	R	Showy Banksia	Small tree / large shrub with yellow flowers during the year. H&W 3-6 m. Sun / light shade. Well drained sandy or loam soils. Attracts bees and nectar feeding birds.Excellent cut flowers.
Banksia	spinulosa 'Coastal Cushion'	R	Hairpin Banksia	Small shrub with gold flower-heads with maroon coloured styles and dense, bright green foliage Aut to Sp. H50cm x W1.5m. Full Sun. Well drained sandy loam soils. Attracts birds.

Bauera	rubiodes (white/rose pink flower)	Y	Dog Rose or River Rose	Hardy, many branched shrub with white to rose pink flowers for most of year. H1.5cm x W2m. Prefers semi shade in most soils. Prune after flowering.

Callistemon	citrinus 'Pink Champagne'	R	Bottlebrush	Shrub with pink, bottlebrush flowers in spring and sometimes autumn. H3m x W1.5-2m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soil types. Prune after flowering. Bird attracting.
Callistemon	glaucus	R		Erect shrub to 2 m. Very dark red upright brushes in Spring to Summer. Full sun. Wet soils but also adaptable to dry conditions. Prune after flowering.
Callistemon	'Mauve Mist'	R		Compact shrub with grey/green leaves and soft mauve bottlebrushes ageing to pale pink in late Sp. H&W 2-3 m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soil types. Prune after flowering. Bird attracting.
Callistemon	subulatus 'Brogo Overflow'	R		Hardy, compact, slightly pendulous shrub with crimson flower spikes in late Sp-S. H1-1.5m. X W1-2.5m. Full-sun/Pt-shade. Most soils. Prune after flowering. Bird attracting.
Callistemon	viminalis "Captain Cook"	R	Weeping Bottlebrush	Medium shrub with abundant bright red flowers in Spring and Summer. H1.0-1.5m x W1.0m. Prefers full sun. All soils.Can be hedged. Attracts birds
Calocephalus	lacteus	O	Milky Beauty-heads	Low, suckering groundcover with soft-grey foliage and clusters of small, cream flowers late Sp to S. H0.3 x W to 1.5m across. Sun/semi-shade. Most soils. Prune after flowering.

Chorizema	cordatum	Y	Heart-leaved Flame Pea	Small, scrambling shrub with eye catching red, yellow, pink flowers mainly in Sp. H1m x W1m. Prefers part-shade. Well drained soil. Responds well to pruning.
Chorizema	cordatum x ilicifolium	Y	Flame Pea	Shrub with eye-catching red, yellow and pink flowers mainly in Sp. H1m x W1m. Some protection from full sun appreciated. Drained soils. Responds well to pruning.

Conospermum	triplinervium	P	Tree Smoke Bush	Large shrub with white/grey flowers, Sp-Sum. H 3-4m X W 1m. All well drained soils. Sun/light shade. Attracts bees/butterflies. Tolerates light frost. Dislikes hot, humid climates
Conospermum	stoechadis	Y	Common Smokebush	Small shrub with white-grey tubular flowers, Sp to Sum. H & W 1.0 -2.0m. Full to part sun. Well drained sandy soils. Suitable for pots. Tolerates moderate frosts and dry periods.
Correa	baeuerlenii	P	Chef's Cap/Hat Correa	Dense, rounded shrub with interesting light green bell flowers in W-Sp. H1-2m x W1.8-2m. Sun/Full shade. Most soils. Prune to create bushiness. Bird attracting.

Corymbia	eximia	R	Yellow Bloodwood	Feature tree with flaky, yellow-brown bark and thick, curved, blue-green leaves. Large creamy flowers in clusters of up to 7 in Sp. H 20m. Full sun in most soils. Attracts birds.
