Acacia	stenophylla	R	Shoe-string Wattle	Small tree with weeping habit and long-narrow leaves. Globular creamy-white flowers in short racemes mainly in Aut. Sun/Pt-Sh. Med to heavy, well drained soil. Salt and frost tolerant.
Adenanthos	sericeus	P	Woolly Bush	Attractive bush with soft, grey-green foliage and small red flowers Sp-Sum. H2-3m x W1.5-3m. Well drained sandy/loam soil. Suits coastal garden. Prune to shape. Attracts birds.
Adenanthos	detmoldii	Y	Yellow Jugflower	Attractive, grey foliated plant with narrow, yellow to orange tubular flowers in late W-Sp. H1.2-1.8m x W1-1.3m. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained soil. Prune to shape. Attracts birds
Alyogyne	huegelii (white flowers)	P	Native Hibiscus	Hardy shrub with white flowers Sp-Aut. H2.5mx W2.5m. Full sun/pt-shade. Well drained sandy loam soils. Prune after flowering to maintain shape. Attracts insects.
Alyogyne	huegelii 'West Coast Gem'	P	Purple Hibiscus	Hardy, bushy shrub with blue flowers Sp-Aut. H2.5mx W2.5m. Full sun/Pt-shade. Well drained sandy loam soils. Prune after flowering to maintain shape. Attracts insects.
Alyogyne	'Blue Heeler'	Y	Native Hibiscus	Small shrub with mauve to purple flowers Sp-Sum. H0.5-0.7m x W0.8-1.0m. Sun/light shade. All well drained soils. Attracts bees, butterflies and other insects.
Amphibromus	sp.	B	Swamp Wallaby Grass	Tall perennial weeping grass for wet areas. Flowers Aug - Nov. H0.5-1.0. Cut back after flowering each year. Not very drought resistant.
Anigozanthos	'Big Red'	B	Kangaroo Paw	Plant with great garden performance. Red flowers late Sp - S. H1-1.3m. Sun/Pt-sh. Most soils. Cut to ground level in Aut; feed in Aut & Sp. Protect from snails. Attracts birds.
Anigozanthos	flavidus (green form)	B	Tall Kangaroo Paw	Plant with great garden performance, green flowers Spr-Sum. H2-3m x W1-2m. Most soils. Sun to light shade. Cut to ground in Aut.Feed in Aut and Spr. Protect from snails. Attracts birds.
Arthropodium	milleflorum	B	Pale Vanilla Lily	Grass-like plant with numerous small, vanilla-scented pale mauve flowers on branched stems to 80cm tall late Sp-S. H20-40cm x W30-50cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained position.
Arthropodium	strictum	B	Chocolate Lily	Grass-like plant with chocolate-scented bluish-mauve flowers on slender stems to 1m. tall late Sp-S. H20-40cm x W20-50cm. Sun/Pt-shade. Well drained position.

Asplenium	austrasicum	B	Birds Nest Fern	Large growing fern with leathery leaves. H1-2m x W4m. Pt-sun/shade position. Plant crown above soil line. Well drained soils. Keep moist in dry periods. Protect from frosts.
Atriplex	nummularia	P	Old Man Saltbush	Hardy, silvery-grey shrub with very small flowers. H1-2m x W2-3m. Well drained sunny position. Prune to shape and desired height. Edible leaves. Tolerates dry conditions. .
Auranticarpa	rhombifolia	P	Diamond Laurel or White Holly	Hardy, small tree with white flowers in summer followed for long periods by orange fruits. H3-4.5m x W1.5x3m. Full sun. Well drained soils. Withstands dry periods.
Austromyrtus	dulcis	Y	Midgen Berry	Hardy, shrub with showy, pinkish-bronze new leaves; small white flowers in Sp-S. followed by edible berries. H0.5m x W1-1.5m. Sun/Pt-shade. Tip-prune. Attracts birds and insects.
Austrostipa	elegantissima	B	Elegant Spear Grass	Tufting perennial grass. Purplish grass panicle in Spr-Sum. H1.0-2.0m x W1.0m. Sun. Alkaline/neutral, sandy/loam/clay soils.Drought, heavy frost tolerant.Food source/habitat birds,butterflies,lizards
Austrostipa	stipoides	G	Coast Spear-Grass	Dense clumping tussock grass with silver-white spikes, Spr-Sum. H&W 0.8m. Full sun. Sandy/loam soils. Attracts seed-eating birds. Salt and wind tolerant. Tolerates dry periods
Austrostipa	verticillata	G	Slender Bamboo Grass	Perennial grass with flowering panicle ranging from 15-60cm most of the year. H 2.0m. Sun/dappled sun. Adaptable to all well drained soils. Provides habitat and food for wildlife.
Baloskion	tetraphyllum	B	Swamp Foxtails	Soft, grass-like clump-forming rush. H1-1.5m x W0.4-1m. Flower turns brown in Sp-Sum. Most soils.
Banksia	marginata	G	Silver Banksia	Hardy shrub with yellow, showy flower-spikes to 10cm long. H2.5-4m x W2-3m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most soils. Benefits from a light pruning. Attracts birds.
Banksia	plagiocarpa	R	Hinchinbrook Blue Banksia	A rare shrub to 5m, can be pruned. Flowers unusual blue-grey up to 14cm. Grows in well drained sandy loam-gravel on a slope in cooler areas. Attractive red velvety new foliage.
Banksia	blechnifolia	R	Fern-leaf Banksia	Dramatic ground cover with dusky-red flower-spikes at ground level on long, lateral branches in Sp-S. Deep lobed leaves to 50cm. Sunny position in a sandy loam. Attracts birds.
Banksia	ericifolia 'Harlequin'	R	Heath Banksia cultivar	Large shrub H4m W4m. Red-white flower spikes W-Sp. Sun/Pt-shade. Frost hardy. Thick needle-like foliage. East- coast native tolerates most soil types. Attracts birds. Can be pruned.
Banksia	gardneri v gardneri	R		Prostrate ground cover 1-2m spreading shrub to 40cm. Flowers rusty brown Sep-Nov. Slow growing. Sandy, loam or gravel with reasonable drainage. Full sun to half shade.
Banksia	'Giant Candles'	R		Shrub with honey coloured flower-spikes 30-40cm long in W-Sp. H3-4m x W2-3m. Full-filtered sun. Moist but well-drained soils. Withstands dry periods. Attracts birds.
Banksia	lemniana	R	Yellow Lantern Banksia	Dense shrub with yellow-green flowers July - Dec. H&W2.0-4.0m. Well drained soils. F-sun/Pt-shade. Withstands frost, drought, some coast exposure. Good windbreak. Attracts birds.
Banksia	media	R	Golden Stalk Banksia	Fast growing shrub or tree with golden yellow flowers from March-August. H 10m - W 3m. Sunny / part shade. Well drained soils. Prune to maintain shape.
Banksia	praemorsa (red)	R	Cut leaf banksia	Upright shrub of variable height 2-5m x W2-3m. New growth soft rusty brown. Large red flower spikes. Well drained soil. Hardy. Full sun. Attracts birds.
Banksia	solandri	R	Stirling Range Banksia	A rare shrub to 4m. Large soft woolly flowers, brown to purple, heavily scented. Attractive large leaves. Grows in sunny well drained gravelly or sandy loam over clay. Tidy prune only.
Banksia	speciosa	R	Showy Banksia	Small tree / large shrub with yellow flowers during the year. H&W 3-6 m. Sun / light shade. Well drained sandy or loam soils. Attracts bees and nectar feeding birds.Excellent cut flowers.
Banksia	spinulosa 'Honeyeater Delig	R		Low-growing dense shrub H0.5mxW1m. Golden flowers Aut-W nectar rich. Sun/Pt-shade. Well-drained soil. Drought frost coastal tolerant. Container plant. Can be pruned

Banksia	spinulosa var cunninghamii	R		Fast growing shrub to H 2.0- 4.0m. Flowers amongst foliage - yellow with stunning black pistils, Aut- Win. Full sun to semi shade. Prefers a well drained heavy soil. Tip prune only.
Bauera	sessiliflora	P	Grampians Bauera	Semi-hardy, spreading plant with showy magenta flowers in spring . H1.8m x W2m. Prefers part-shade in well drained soil. Prune after flowering. Tolerates dry periods.
Beaufortia	sparsa (orange flower)	P	Gravel Bottlebrush	Bush with orange bottle brush flowers Dec-April. H1.3-2m x W0.8-1.5m. Well drained soil in sunny position. Prune behind flower heads to promote growth. Attracts birds
Boronia	denticulata	Y	Mauve Boronia	Rounded, hardy shrub with star-like pink flowers in spring. H1m x W60cm with toothed leaves. Sun/Pt-shade. Moist well-drained loam or sandy soils. Tip prune.
Boronia	heterophylla 'Pixie'	Y		Small shrub with aromatic leaves, pink flowers in Spring. H1.0m x W0.75m. Well drained slightly acidic soils. Full sun to part shade. Lightly prune after flowering.

Bossiaea	walkeri	P	Cactus Bossiaea	Medium shrub, upright to spreading with pea-shaped bright red flowers, Apr- Sept. H&W 1.5 -2.5m. Partial sun. All well drained soils. Withstands limited pruning. Frost & drought tolerant
Bossiaea	riparia	Y	River Leafless Bossiaea	Upright leafless dwarf shrub, with pale yellow flowers Aug - Nov. H & W0.5-1.0m. Pref dappled shade or part sun. Pref well-drained soil but will grow well in wet. Hardy to frost.
Bulbine	bulbosa	B	Bulbine Lily	Perennial with yellow flowers on stems to 40cm tall in Sp-S. May die back to tuberous rootstock late summer. H20-50cm x W20-30cm. Full sun to Pt-shade. Most soils.
Callistemon	brachyandrus	R	Prickly bottlebrush	Small to tall dense rounded shrub with red brushes and yellow anthers in Summer. H1-5m x W1-3m. Full sun. Well drained soils. Prune after flowering. Refuge for birds. Good background shrub.
Calothamnus	quadrididus (grey form)	P	Common Net Bush	Compact shrub with grey foliage and red flowers as a one-sided spike in Sp. H2-3m x W2-3m. Sun/Pt-shade. Responds to pruning. Attracts birds.
Calothamnus	rupestris	P	Mouse Ears	Bushy shrub with large, reddish-pink flowers Spr. H1m-2.5 x W2-3m. F-sun/Pt-sh. Well drained soils. Withstands light frosts, wind and moderate coastal exposure. Attracts birds
Carpobrotus	rossii (pink/purple flower)	O	Native Pigface	Hardy, spreading ground cover with succulent leaves and purple flowers in Sp & S. Spreads to 2m. Sunny position in well-drained soils. Suitable for dry areas.
Carpobrotus	rossii (white flower)	O	Native Pigface	Hardy, spreading ground cover with succulent leaves and with flowers in Sp-S. Spread to 2m. Sunny position and well-drained soils. Suitable for dry areas.

Eremophila	debilis	Pink	Winter Apple	Glabrous, prostrate, spreading shrub with small, white star-shaped flowers Sp. followed by green to reddish-purple fruit. Spread 1.5m. Sunny position. Attracts birds.
Eremophila	decipiens	Pink	Slender Fuchsia	Small shrub with red tubular flowers in Sp. H1-2m x W1-2m. Sun/Pt-shade. Most well-drained soils. Hardy to frost and dry spells. Responds well to pruning. Attracts birds.
Eremophila	decipiens ssp linearfolia	Pink	Narrow Fuschia	Low bush with red flowers in Spring. H 0.9-1 m x 1.5m. Full sun-part shade. Well drained soils. Prune for good shape. Suitable for container. Bird attracting
Eremophila	drummondii x nivea 'Eyre Princess'	Pink		Shrub with mauve flowers in Spring. H1.5-2m x W1.3m. Needs full sun. Dislikes wet conditions. Attracts insects.
Eremophila	glabra (red flowers)	Pink		Open, silver- foliated shrub with red flowers from spring to summer. H 1-1.5m x W1-1.5m. Full sun. Most well drained soils. Prune for good shape. Attracts birds.
Eremophila	glabra 'Belalla Gold'	Pink		Dense, low-prostrate shrub with masses of yellow flowers from late Spring to Autumn. H0.2m x W2.0m. Sun/Pt-shade. Suitable for containers. Good ground cover. Attracts birds.
Eremophila	glabra 'Ceduna'	Pink		Small compact shrub with dark orange/red flowers most of the year. H1m x W1.5m. Well drained soils. Prune for shape.
Eremophila	glabra 'Fruit Salad'	Pink		Low growing bush with yellow, orange flowers in Winter and Spring. H0.45m x W0.60m. Warm sunny site in well drained soils. Prune to keep good shape. Attracts birds.

Eremophila	glabra 'Kalbarri Carpet'	Pink		Dense groundcover with yellow flowers in Spring-Summer. H0.2m x W1m. Warm, dry, sunny position. Good drainage. Attracts birds.

Eremophila	glabra x maculata	Pink		Shrub with red flowers, Spring-Summer. H0.8-1.0 x W1.0-1.5m. Best in full sun. All soils. Prune hard for good shape. Bird attracting.
Eremophila	maculata (apricot flower)	Pink		Attractive bush with apricot flowers with spotted throat in Spring to Winter. H1.5 x W1.0m. Full sun. Tolerates most soils. Lightly prune lightly to shape. Attracts birds.
Eremophila	maculata (purple flowers)	Pink		Upright, long-flowering shrub with bright purple flowers in spring. H1-1.5m x W1.5-1.8m. Filtered - full sun. Well drained soil. Prune after flowering to keep compact. Attracts birds.
Eremophila	maculata x racemosa	Pink		Shrub with pink flowers in early Summer. H to 1.5m. Full sun. Clay to sandy soils. Light prune beneficial. Bird attracting.
