Acacia	binervia	R	Coast Myall Wattle	Adaptable, small tree with rod-like yellow flowers in spring. H&W 5-8m. Sunny position in well drained soils. Drought and frost tolerant. Attracts wildlife. Good for erosion control.
Acacia	boormanii	R	Snowy River Wattle	Small tree with bright yellow flowers in late W-Sp. H to 4m. Tolerates most well-drained soils. Prune for bushiness. Spectacular when in flower. Tends to sucker.
